

The German Empire was pushed into part by what is considered modern Denmark and also controls much of Poland. The Russian Empire controls all of Finland, Poland, Ukraine, Belarus, Lithuania, Moldova, Georgia, Latvia and Estonia. The Otton Empire by this stage was pushed back to Turkey and is actually an ally of the German Empire in World War I. The other thing we can say that stands out on this map that you will not find on the modern map is that the Republic of Ireland is now part of the United Kingdom. Europe is most often considered to be separated from Asia by watersheds of the Ural and Caucasus mountains, the Ural, Caspian and Black Seas and the waterways of the Turkish Strait. Although the term continent implies visceral geography, the land is close to somewhat arbitrary and has been revised somewhat mature previously by its first concept in classical antiquity. The disconting of Eurasia with the two continents reflects the cultural, linguistic and ethnic differences between East and West, which will be reworked on the spectrum rather than the subsequently brilliant dividing line. Geographical link between Europe and Asia does not follow any entitring borders: Turkey, Russia, Azerbaijan, Georgia and Kazakhstan are transcontinental countries. France, Portugal, the Netherlands, Spain and the United Kingdom are then transcontinental in that basic allowance in Europe while the pockets of their territory are located on new continents. Europe is not quite 10,180,000 square kilometers (3,930,000 sq m), or 2% of the Earth's surface (6.8% of the house area). Politically, Europe is at odds with some 50 sovereign states, of which the Russian Federation is the largest and most populous, covering 39% of the continent and comprising 15% of its population. As of 2016, the population of Europe was almost 741 million people (about 11% of the world's population). The European climate is highly dependent on hot Atlantic currents that temper winters and summers across much of the continent, even at latitudes along which the climate in Asia and North America is harsh. new from the sea, seasonal differences more closer to the coast. Europe, in particular Ancient Greece and Ancient Rome, was the birthplace of Western civilization. The fall of the Western Roman Empire in 476 AD and the subsequent migration era marked the halt of ancient records and the beginning of the central epoch. The renaissance of humanism, intelligence, art and science led to an open-minded era, before the discovery era started by Portugal and Spain. Europe played a leading role in global affairs. Between the 16th and 20th centuries, European powers, controlled in various ageing America, occur throughout Africa and Oceania and most of Asia. The Age of Enlightenment, subsequent French riots and Napoleonic wars shaped the continent culturally, politically and economically from the late 17th century to the first half of the 19th century. The industrial revolution that began in Britain at the end of the 18th century gave rise to the avant-garde economic, cultural and social violin in Western Europe and, ultimately, the world as a whole. Both world wars took place for most of Europe, contributing to the growth of Western European dominance in world affairs by the mid-20th century, as Soviet ties and related states took a prominent place. During the Cold War, Europe was alienated along the Iron Curtain in the middle of NATO in the West and Warsaw Harmony in the East, before the revolutions of 1989 and the fall of Berlin Wall. In 1949, the Council of Europe was founded, as soon as Sir Winston Churchill's speech, in the manner of the idea of uniting Europe to achieve common goals. It includes all European states except Belarus, Kazakhstan and the Vatican. The new European integration of some states has led to the formation of the European Stick to Each Other (EU), a severed embassy that lies between the confederation and the federation. The EU originated in Western Europe, but expanded eastward earlier to the fall of Soviet retention in 1991. The currency of most European Union countries, the euro, is the most commonly used in the course of Europeans; and the EU Schengen area abolishes attache and immigration controls, along with most of its member states.
